

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

- 1.0 Except as provided by law, all meetings of the Board of Education will be open to the public.
- 2.0 The Board may hold executive sessions upon recorded vote of 3/5 of the members present and voting, and any motion to go into executive session will indicate the nature of the business of the executive session. Deliberations may be concluded in executive sessions only on those matters defined in the law.
- 3.0 By its very nature, the subject matter of executive sessions is highly confidential. It is expected that all parties to such discussions will respect the need for confidentiality.
