## **PUBLIC NOTICE** **Scarborough School Department** **Scarborough, Maine** **Asbestos Annual Notification**

Pursuant to the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) notice is hereby given that the Scarborough School Department has surveyed its buildings for the presence of asbestos materials. A Plan to manage those materials and response actions is available by contacting the Director of Facilities at Superintendent's Office, PO Box 370, Scarborough, ME 04070-0370.

### **Brief Summary & History of Asbestos Activities:**

#### **1988 District-wide**

Asbestos identification and evaluation surveys were conducted in all Scarborough school facilities in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 763, Asbestos-Containing Materials in School; Final Rule Notice.

#### **1988-1992 Scarborough High, Eight Corners, Blue Point and Pleasant Hill Schools**

The asbestos-containing materials previously identified were removed (abated) as part of the construction and renovation projects for Scarborough High School, Eight Corners School, Blue Point and Pleasant Hill Schools. Project construction specifications required no asbestos material be used in the renovation and additions. Detailed asbestos abatement reports are kept as part of the districts Asbestos Management Plan permanent records. No known asbestos exists in these schools.

#### **1996 Scarborough Middle School**

The Middle School was constructed in 1996, project bid specifications required no asbestos containing materials be used in the building.

#### **1988-2009 Wentworth Intermediate School**

Asbestos containing materials including boiler coverings, pipe fittings, floor tiles and mastics were identified as part of Wentworth's initial assessment. Since 1988 the district has abated all boiler coverings, pipe fittings and 75% of the floor tiles and mastic. Remaining asbestos containing materials are maintained and periodically inspected in accordance with AHERA requirements. Abatement reports are kept as part of the districts Asbestos Management Plan permanent records
