

Graduation Information for the Class of 2010

Josten's is the company with whom we work for diplomas and caps & gowns. Their representative will be **at school** on **Tuesday, January 26th** to meet with seniors regarding cap and gown, **announcement, and other memorabilia options**. The school will cover the cost of cap and gown and diploma; any announcements or other materials will be at the discretion of the family. He will return to take orders on **Tuesday, February 2nd** during the lunch periods. In case of a snow day on that date, orders are to be turned in to Ms. Gagnon by the end of that week.

Reminder – all seniors are expected to be in attendance at school through the months of May and June. Please be sure to plan any family vacations during school vacation time or after graduation week.

The week before graduation is usually a very busy one. Some classes have scheduled a semi-formal dinner for their classmates and teachers on Monday evening.

On Wednesday evening the local area churches usually sponsor a Baccalaureate celebration for Scarborough residents who attend all of the area public and private high schools. Tickets to this event are limited and are organized through the church group.

On **Thursday evening, June 10th**, we will hold our **final assembly**. This will be the last time the students will assemble as a class at Scarborough High School. They will meet prior to the assembly to have a class picture taken in the Alumni Gym and then process in cap and gown to the auditorium where scholarships and other awards will be presented. This event is open to the community with no tickets required.

The Class of 2010 of Scarborough High School is scheduled to graduate on **Sunday, June 13, 2010 at 7:00 pm at the Cumberland County Civic Center in Portland.**

The Class of 2010 currently has 292 students and the limit for the stage at Merrill Auditorium is 250! We have a wonderful working relationship with the management of the Civic Center and anticipate as formal and impressive a graduation as we have had in the past with smaller classes at the Auditorium.

Project Graduation – A dedicated group of Scarborough residents each year has made a chemical free, all night celebration available to our graduates for many years. This tradition began in the state more than 25 years ago when the number of graduates who were dying due to alcohol or other drug involved accidents was found to be intolerable.
